**ORDER**

**Sub: Incentive in tariff to Large Industrial Consumers  
Modification in the existing schemes and the  
extensions of the modified scheme for a further  
period of 03 years upto 31-03-2007.**

With a view to encourage growth in industrial consumption by large industrial consumers, an incentive scheme for granting concession in tariff to the large industrial consumers was introduced by Jodhpur Discom duly approved by R.E.R.C. This scheme was applicable for the year 2003-04 and was made applicable in the first instance vide Order Comml./JDP/161 and clarification in the matter was issued vide Comml./JDP/167.

In the aforesaid incentive scheme, it was prescribed that the proposed incentive scheme shall not be admissible to consumers who have not completed 12 months operation by 31-03-2003. Thus new/reconnected consumers whose connection were released/reconnected during 2002-2003 and had not completed 12 months operation by 31-03-2003 were debarred from getting concession under the incentive scheme. Similarly, it was also prescribed that incentive under the scheme shall not be admissible to consumers who have reduced their contract demand during the year 2003-04.

In view of the pressing requests from consumers, proposal was moved to RERC for modification in the existing scheme so as to include new/reconnected consumers who have not completed 12 months by 31-03-2003 and also consumers who had reduced their contract demand during 2003-04 under the ambit of concession scheme. The modified scheme for the year 2003-04 as above, and also proposals for extension of the modified scheme for a further period of 03 years i.e. upto 31-03-2007 was moved to RERC for its approval.

The Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission has accorded approval of the aforesaid proposals thereby modifying existing scheme and also for extension of the modified scheme for a further period of three years subject to the following conditions :

1. Incentive shall be allowed to new/reconnected consumers only after completion of initial twelve months operation. The incentive will be allowed for the remaining period of the financial year in which the new/reconnected consumer completes twelve months operation in case the consumer exceeds the average consumption of twelve months operation by 2.5% in the remaining period of the financial year. The incentive for subsequent years shall be applicable financial yearwise with 2.5% annual increase in consumption.

2. The incentive shall also be allowed to the consumer who has reduced his contract demand during current year, provided energy consumption during current year has increased by more than 2.5% of that of base year. The incentive @ 15% shall be admissible if during current year the load factor of more than 50% is achieved with the higher contract demand of the base year; otherwise the incentive shall be admissible @ 10% only.

3. The existing scheme is extended for the consumer raising his consumption by more than 2.5% each year as well as to new/reconnected consumers as per 1. above for a further period of three years i.e. upto 31-03-2007. To elaborate, for existing consumers, admissibility will be as under :

- a) For FY 2004-05, the consumption has to be 5.0% more than the consumption of the base year FY 2002-2003 to avail the incentive.
- b) For FY 2005-06, the consumption has to be 7.5% more than the consumption of the base year FY 2002-03 to avail the incentive.
- c) For FY 2006-07, the consumption has to be 10% more than the consumption of the base year 2002-03 to avail the incentive.

4. However, in case of new/reconnected consumers, the base year shall be initial twelve months period operation and the admissibility will be as under :

- a) On causing 2.5% more consumption in the remaining period of F.Y. in which he completes 12 months operation .
- b) For subsequent financial years, increase of 5%, 7.5% and 10% in consumption shall be needed to avail the benefit.

To elaborate above, admissibility shall be as under :

- i) New connection to a large industry if released on 01-08-2002, first twelve months operation will be completed on 31-07-2003. The base year of consumer shall be consumption for the period 01-08-2002 to 31-07-2003.
- ii) To avail incentive for remaining period of FY 2003-04, the consumption has to be 2.5% more than the consumption of the base year.

iii) To avail incentive for FY 2004-05, the consumption has to be 05% more than the consumption of the base year.

iv) To avail incentive for FY 2005-06, the consumption has to be 7.5% more than the consumption of the base year

v) To avail incentive for FY 2006-07, the consumption has to be 10% more than the consumption of the base year.


5. For availing higher incentive of 15%, a load factor of the consumer (who has not reduced contract demand) shall be considered for the year for which incentive is considered instead of base year.

6. The incentive shall be allowed quarterly on cumulative basis of assessment subject to the final assessment at the end of the year on year to year basis.

7. Incentive as per the scheme modified/extended as above, shall be admissible to the consumers from third-quarter of financial year 2004 and shall be applicable upto dt.31-03-2007 or till the Commission issues tariff order, whichever is earlier. While considering tariff petition, scheme shall be reviewed interalia based on tariff proposal.

Other terms and conditions of the modified as well as extended scheme would be same as prescribed under Order Comml./JDP/161 and Comml./JDP/167.
