ORDER


Sub: Recovery of difference of stamp duty in respect of agreement etc. from consumers.

Consequent upon enactment of the Rajasthan Financial Act w.e.f. 12th March, 1997, stamp duty in respect of agreements for new connection was raised from Rs.10.00 to Rs.100.00. Accordingly, for the applications filed for new connections in the sub-divisions of erstwhile RSEB the stamp duty @ Rs.100.00 per connection was required to be obtained.

As the order of the State Government was not received timely and necessary orders for enhancement of the stamp duty were issued vide Comml.311 dated 12-09-97. Due to this time lag, for the applications for new connection lodged in the sub-divisions between the period 12th March, 1997 to 12th Sept., 1997, short stamp duty was recovered and instead of Rs.100.00, Rs.10.00 per connection was paid by the consumers towards stamp duty.

For the recovery of the stamp duty, less paid by some of the consumers @ Rs.90.00 per connection, the matter was moved to the State Government. The State Government had discussed this matter with the officers of Jodhpur Discom and it has been decided that the difference of Rs.90.00 be recovered from the applicants who had paid the stamp duty @ Rs.10.00 instead of Rs.100.00 through energy bills in three equal installments commencing from the billing month of June, 2004.

After recovery of the short fall of stamp duty, the same is required to be intimated to the Chief Accounts Officer, Jodhpur Discom, Jodhpur, sub-division wise, who will ensure that the amount of security so recovered is paid to the State Government.
