ORDER


Sub: Assessment in case of stopped/ stolen/ lost or burnt Meter.

In the "Terms and Condition for Supply of Electricity-2004" approved by Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission under Clause 27, it has been prescribed that for Agriculture category consumers, the consumption of electricity in cases of stopped/stolen/lost or burnt Meters shall be assessed on the basis of 100% load factor by considering 6 Units/HP/day and for 4Units/HP/day for the billing months of Oct. to April and from May to September every year for Block Supply Connections. Similarly for other connections, the assessment has been prescribed as 12 units per HP per day and 8 Units per HP per day from the billing months of Oct. to April and May to September every year.

The public representative(s) hence expressed serious concern over a new assessment procedure as prescribed in the Terms and Conditions of Supply-2004 on the plea that it is very harsh. This matter was discussed and decided that as the matter has been referred by the State Government vide letter No. F12 (1)Energy /2004/D.1909 dt.27-04-05 for issuing policy directive to the RERC in terms of Section-108 of the Electricity Act-2003 for continuing the old procedure instead of revised one. It was considered that earlier provisions in case of stopped/stolen/lost or burnt Meter i.e. charging the consumer on the basis of Agriculture Flat rate be followed. As such it is hereby ordered that the assessment in case of stopped/stolen/lost or burnt Meter be made by charging flat rate from such consumers for the period the meter has remained stopped/lost/stolen or burnt.

The charging as prescribed herein before is on provisional basis subject to approval of RERC in this regard.
