ORDER

Sub: Change of category from SIP to MIP on eventualities arisen when maximum demand exceeds 25 HP (18.65 KW) on three occasions in a financial year.

It was prescribed in the Order Comml.JDP/255 dt.19-02-2005 on the subject that in case Small Industrial consumers exceed the maximum demand of 25 KVA, thrice in a financial year the connection be converted compulsorily to Medium Industrial Service. Difficulties were expressed by the field officers in implementation of the above mentioned order on the grounds that the whole current meters installed for SIP connections record the maximum demand in KW and not in KVA.

This matter was therefore put up for considerations of the Coordination Committee in its 82nd meeting held on 30-04-2005 wherein it was decided that the action for converting the SIP connection to MIP connection in terms of Order Comml.JDP/255 is to be taken if the maximum demand of the consumer exceeds 18.65 KW.

The Order Comml.JDP/255 be treated as modified partially to the above extent.
