**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: Relief to domestic and agriculture consumers.**

Following reliefs have been allowed by the State Government vide Energy Department Order dated 26-05-2005. Therefore, revision of tariff is to be effected for all such consumers as narrated below :

1. **KUTIR JYOTI IN RURAL AREA AND BELOW POVERTY LINE CONSUMERS IN KACHHI BASTIES OF URBAN AREAS :**

Tariff Code 1400 is hereby prescribed for consumers below poverty line in Kachhi Basties of urban areas. For Kutir Jyoti consumers, tariff code is already in existence. First 50 units per month of such consumers would be billed @ 85 paise per unit i.e. half of the pre-revised tariff of first 50 units slab and thereafter for consumption more than 50 units per month, revised rates for higher slab i.e. Rs.3.50 per unit would be recovered Fixed Charges is recoverable only @ Rs. 50 per month.

For this purpose following be done :

- List to be collected for Kacchi Basties and residing BPL families therein from all Nagar Palikas/Municipal Councils.
- By survey, earmark active Domestic connection released in the name of head of those BPL families or in the name of any member of such families.
- Apply tariff code 1400 for such selected domestic connections and thereafter send to Billing Agency.

All SE's are requested to complete aforesaid activity before 15-11-2005.

2. **SMALL DOMESTIC CONNECTIONS IN RURAL & URBAN AREAS :**

In this category, consumers whose average monthly consumption is upto 50 units per month in the previous financial year would be covered. Accordingly, first 50 units per month would be billed @ Rs.1.70 per unit and thereafter for consumption exceeding 50 units per month, revised rate for higher slab i.e. Rs.3.50 per unit would be recovered. No relief in respect of new connections released during the year is admissible at the moment, however, these consumers would be entitled for relief in the next year if above relief package remain in force.

It may be noted that demand to the consumers i.e. the energy bills would be sent after giving relief as per package as narrated above but assessment will be carried out in the ledgers as well as in MIS on the basis of tariff order dated 17-12-2004. The difference between the two amounts is since recoverable from the State Government, same may be shown in the bill as well as ledgers as per existing practice. In the ledgers assessment as per revised tariff and also as per bill be shown separately in respect of such consumers eligible for tariff concession. This relief package is applicable for the consumption made w.e.f. 01-05-2005, therefore, billing from the month of June, 2005 be revised accordingly.
