ORDER

Sub: Charging consumers in case of Magnetic Temper.

Recently supplied HT TVM has a software having characteristic that during the period of application of magnet, the demand of meters increases upto ten times of load during the period of application of magnet. Such events fall under the definition of the act of theft of Electricity as per Clause No.135(1)(b) of the Indian Electricity Act,2003. Besides above, this is also covered under the Clause No.138(1)(d) defined as "Interference with meters or works of Licensee".

The matter was discussed in 93rd Coordination Committee Meeting held on 24th April, 2006 and it was decided that wherever magnetic tamper is observed, the consumer shall be booked for theft of electricity, instead of charging for increased demand during the period of application of magnet.

Strict compliance of above be ensured by all concerned.
