ORDER

Sub : Rebate of 7.5% to be allowed to the consumers under
Bulk Supply of Mixed Load (Schedule ML/LT-7)
For supply on HT.

On the subject cited above, a review petition was filed before R.E.R.C. for reviewing their order dtd.24-03-01 and 01-04-02 in respect of rebate of 7.5% to be allowed to the consumers under Bulk Supply of Mixed Load (Schedule ML/LT-7) for supply on HT.

The Hon'ble Commission has passed an order dtd.01-07-06 giving the operative portion of the order is reproduced hereunder :

Para-16

"We, therefore, do not consider any review of our order dated 24-03-01 or 01-04-02 and clarify that the rebate to the consumers, under Schedule ML/LT-7, and taking supply at 11KV or higher voltage shall continue to them w.e.f. 01-04-01 and direct the licensees that the amount already charged in excess shall be adjusted against the future bills not beyond the billing month of October, 2006 if any amount on account of rebate to be allowed is not fully settled through adjustment from bills, on aforesaid, then the same shall be paid in cash to the respondents by end of Oct., 06 failing which the respondent shall be entitled for interest @ 12% per annum on the balance amount. The petition is disposed with no order as to cost".

Based on this, following directions are issued :-

- (1) Rebate @ 7.5% to the consumers under tariff schedule ML/LT-7 having supply at 11 KV or higher voltage, be continued with effect from 01-04-01.

-: 2 :-

- (2) The amount already charged in excess for the period from billing month of May, 2001 to Feb., 2003 be refunded in three equal monthly installments through adjustment in the energy bills to be issued for billing months of August, September and October, 2006.
- (3) Any amount on account of rebate to be allowed if not fully refunded through adjustment in bills upto billing month of October, 2006, the same be refunded through A/C pay cheque by the end of October, 2006, failing which the consumer will be entitled for interest @ 12% per annum on the balance amount.

It is, therefore, enjoined upon all the field officers to ensure that the amount of rebate not allowed to the consumers during the billing months of May, 2001 to February, 2003 is refunded to the consumer through adjustment as stated hereinabove. After refund of the said amount the compliance report by compiling the same at Circle Level, be forwarded to this office.
