### ORDER

Sub : Clarification regarding applicability of tariff to be levied on electric connection taken under Community Kitchen being set up by the Govt. Mid Day Meal Programme in the State.

Community Kitchens are being set up by the State Govt. for initiating the Mid Day Meal Scheme for school children in the State. This scheme is proposed in the public private partnership initiative under which community kitchens for preparation of meals would be set up at the State. It has been reported that for electric connection of Community Kitchens in some cases non domestic tariff is being applied by field officers, which is not correct.

The issue regarding applicability of tariff for community kitchens has been examined and in view of the fact that no commercial activity is carried out by these kitchens which are running on "No Profit & No Loss basis", the application of non domestic tariff for these connections is not appropriate. As the activity undertaken by community kitchens under Mid Day Meal Scheme is for school children, the tariff applicable for Recognised Education Centers/schools is Mixed Load Tariff, the same can be aptly applied for such kitchens as based on activity, such kitchens can be considered as part and parcel of schools. Further, since the tariff schedule ML/LT-7 or ML/HT-4 depending upon the load of the community kitchens should be applied for such installations.

It should, therefore be ensured by the field officers that correct tariff schedule in terms of the "Tariff for Supply of Electricity-04", i.e. Mixed Load Tariff Schedule, ML/LT-7 or ML/HT-4, depending upon voltage of supply/load should be made applicable for such connections.
