ORDER

**Sub: Amendment in Clause 20 (d) of "General  
Conditions of Supply & Misc.Charges relating  
to supply of electricity".**

\*\*\*\*\*

The Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission has passed an Order dated 24th March, 2001 in Petition No.RERC/Tariff/7/2000 filed on behalf of Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited for fixation of tariff for retail supply of electricity. The Regulatory Commission interalia directed the Jodhpur Discom that those consumers who are regular in payment of their bills should not be subjected to payment of increased amount of security to bring it to an amount equal to two months bill at a subsequent time. It has also been directed that Railways will not be required to make security deposits in future. Hence the existing clause 20 (d) of GCOS is modified to that extent by adding the following para (s) at the end of the existing clause 20 (d).

" Consumers other than tenants who do not default in payment of their bills in time more than once in a financial year shall not be required to pay any increase in security amount as a result of review of security. In case such a consumer defaults more than once in any financial year or two consecutive months spread over two financial years in payment of his bills in time, the Jodhpur Discom would be free to have the security amount enhanced so as to be equal to two months bill in respect of such defaulting consumers in a financial year.

All Central and State Government Departments are exempted from requirement of security deposit. No security deposit shall be required to be recovered from new connections of Railway Department. Further, no additional security shall be recovered from existing connections of Railway Department".

The above provision shall come into force with immediate effect.
