ORDER

Sub: Regarding voltage rebate in tariff for the connections released on 33 KV supply instead of 11 KV for which the consumer is entitled to be supplied power.

In accordance with the provisions under Clause-2 of "Terms & Conditions for Supply of Electricity" (TCOS), the Nigam may allow supply to a consumer at a voltage level one stage higher or lower in exceptional circumstances. In light of this cases are being received from the consumers for releasing new connections for a contract demand below 1500 KVA or for extension in contract demand (Total demand after extension remains below 1500 KVA), requesting for releasing power on 33KV instead of prescribed 11 KV. Normally such request is also received when 11 KV network is away from the consumer premises and 33 KV system is nearby. These requests are considered and depending upon the reasons/justification & on the basis of merits of individual case, approval of Hon'ble CMD are conveyed.

In this connection, it is to inform that in such cases the supply at 33KV is being allowed on the request of the consumer himself, but in all such cases the consumers allowed voltage rebate of 0.75% on billed amount.

The matter has been reviewed and it has been decided that henceforth rebate @ 0.75% on billed amount for 33 KV supply shall not be allowed in such cases.

It is also enjoined upon all concerned that in the similar cases sanctioned in the past, rebate @ 0.75% being given, be stopped with immediate effect.
