

## RVUNL: Achievements for FY 2015-16

### i. Capacity addition

600 MW U #2 of Kalisindh Thermal Power Project, Jhalawar added in generation capacity of RVUN in Year-2015-16. COD achieved on 25.07.2015.

### ii. Allotment of Coal Blocks

Two new coal blocks viz. Kente extension and Parsa allotted on 31.03.15 & 24.03.15 respectively.

### iii. Increase in production of Raw Coal

Production of raw coal from Coal Mines "Parsa East and Kanta Basan" increased from 34.42 lacs MT in 2014-15 to 62.09 lacs MT in 2015-16.

### iv. Improvement in Station Heat Rate of RVUN power plants w.r.t. 2014-15

### v. Action taken in fuel division to reduce the cost of generation wrt FY 2014-15:

#### i. Stoppage of imported coal

Import of coal stopped; which reduced the cost of fuel consumed wrt 2014-15.

#### ii. Coal Swapping

Swapping of domestic coal adopted between KTPS & STPS, and saved on account of transportation charges.

#### iii. Deferment of coal supplies from Korea Rewaa due to high grade slippage problem.

All above three components together saved about **250 Crs.i.e. 200 Crs at KTPS, 35 Crs at STPS and 12 Crs at CTPP U#1&2.**

### vi. Reduction in Financial Losses

Financial losses reduced from Rs. 2637 crores in FY 2014-15 to Rs. 1000 -1100crores (anticipated) in FY 2015-16.

### vii. Disinvestment

Cabinet approval received for disinvestment of Chhabra and Kalisindh power stations.

### viii. Recruitment

Appointment given to 638 persons, as per details given below:-
